How to Use Your Digital Camera

If you're frustrated with your digital camera and feel you could do more with it, this class is for you. If you have a digital SLR and you want to branch out and use some of the manual features and over-rides your camera provides, this is the class for you. In this hands-on class you will learn how to set your camera to get the pictures you want. We'll talk about why the Automatic settings may not give you good, consistence results and you'll learn the work-arounds. We'll start with some photography basics, move into all the buttons, knobs, and switches, then head to the computer lab to learn about downloading and organizing the photos once you take them.

Flash Photography Made Easy

90% of all photographers (including professionals) are afraid of their flash. It's time to take control and give yourself new ways to control the light in your photography. In this 5 hour hands-on class you'll learn just how simple it is to take great flash pictures. You'll also learn just how important and life-saving using flash can be. It is recommended that you have an SLR camera and an external flash unit (aka speedlight). Small point and shoot cameras will not be sufficient to take advantage of this class. This class is designed for beginner to advanced users who really want to master their flash.
